Oceans (Where my feet fall) by Hillsong

The first line of the chorus is "Spirit lead me where my trust is without borders." I have thought a lot about that line and so want my life to be like that. I know it's not yet by any means but I also know I am a lot nearer to it than I used to be. If I were to tell you about my life many years ago when I had a severe drug problem, eating disorders, an extremely dysfunctional life style and two prison sentences to boot you would find it very hard to believe but it would explain why I still suffer with self-doubt and lack of confidence. I was given a prophecy in 2008 which contained this sentence within it: "I look at you and see a woman who has lived through many fires in your life, there has been a lot of shaking and a lot of opposition has come against you throughout your life, the Lord is bringing a wave of healing to you, physical healing coming to you like a rain and a physical healing coming to strengthen you ..."

I am sharing that to encourage you, so that whatever has gone, whatever is happening now, whatever you fear or doubt, God has it all in hand. He wants to lead you to a place where your trust will not have borders even if it takes a life time BUT it doesn't just happen, you have to BELIEVE to OBEY to LISTEN to RECEIVE to SURRENDER to BE TEACHABLE to be HUMBLE and to FORGIVE but it's all so worth it.

A lady wrote this, I don't know her name, but I can relate to it:

To trust God without borders in my life is huge, to protect myself from the pains of life I have had huge control issues and yet God so lovingly and kindly has helped me let go of my life and place it in his hands.
