### Thought for the Week – from Caroline

**James 1:22-25** *Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it-not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it-they will be blessed in what they do.*

To me, this doesn't just speak about physical actions or works we do but also obeying the Lord when he points out the flaws in our characters that need addressing or the strongholds that need to be broken that bind us and

stop our growth. We are so blind to these things very often but the Lord will open the eyes of a humble and teachable person/heart. The way you lead your life, the way you speak, your willingness to surrender or change your rigid perceptions and examine yourself, to meditate on your motives, to be sexually pure and for our yes to be yes and our no to be no is as important, if not more so, than any activities you do (which God may not have even asked you to do).

Two scriptures to carry in your heart daily:

**Psalm 19:14** *May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer.*

**Luke 6:31** *Do to others as you would have them to do to you.*
