Thought for the Week — from Caroline

No Other Gospel

Galatians 1:6-9

I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you to live in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel – which is really no gospel at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the gospel of Christ. But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let them be under God's curse! As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let them be under God's curse!

This scripture doesn't really need a lot of explanation; Paul is astonished that they have so quickly defected from the truth and are perverting the gospel to their own way of thinking that suits them. Isn't that exactly what's happening today? Justifying and accommodating the world's philosophies to please people or to look like you are caring and have empathy to lifestyles that are not Godly, in other words rearranging the gospel to fit in. You can be compassionate, caring and have immense empathy without compromise or distorting scripture. Jesus did, He spent time with sinners and loved them but never condoned their sin or changed His message to please them; He wanted them free and saved. "The gospel other than what you accepted" can be very very subtle but we need to keep close to God's word so that we recognise the counterfeit. People who are trained to spot counterfeit money do so by studying the authentic bank notes so carefully and with such focus they can immediately identify the fake.
