### Thought for the Week – from Caroline

**Stop judging and you will not be judged. Stop condemning and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven ... For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you. (Luke 6:37-38)**

**Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you. (Matthew 7:1-2)**

I think this scripture is so misused and causes a lot of confusion, I have mentioned it before. This scripture is used to silence people who point out an issue that is needing to be addressed or have discerned behaviours or situations that also need prayer or action. The judgement in question is not about right or wrong but about us not condemning or bringing condemnation on people. Only God knows why that person has done what they have done, what has driven them, what has influenced them, what state their heart and mind is in. God's desire is for everybody to be redeemed, unfortunately that will not happen because of man's free will, but we are not to know who will turn from their wicked ways so we must reach out to all. "Do I take any pleasure in the death of the wicked? declares the Sovereign LORD. Rather, am I not pleased when they turn from their ways and live?" (Ezekiel 18:23) All sin, even the smallest sin, is rebellion to God.

The parable that follows this about the speck of dust in your brother's eye when there is a plank in your own does NOT mean you don't correct sinners, it just means be right with God yourself and not a hypocrite.
