Thought for the Week – from Caroline

Hebrews 4:13 "Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account."

Matthew 12:36 "But I tell you that everyone will have to give account on the day of judgement for every empty word they have spoken."

When I was at the Prophetic Conference last week Isabel Allum shared that in the Spirit (in the supernatural) she was in a room in heaven where there was a large table with an angel at each end and one in the middle writing in the biggest book she had ever seen in her life. The book was *The Book of Life* (referred to seven times in Revelation), there was a separate page for the name of every believer and there were three columns; the first column was headed Promises (that is all the promises given to you by God), the second column was headed Commitments (all the things you have committed to do) and the third column Deeds done for the Lord. We will be rewarded for the promises we have

held to, the commitments we have fulfilled, and the deeds we have done for the Lord. Those sins we have repented of and been forgiven for are washed away by the blood of the Lamb (Jesus's death and sacrifice on the cross – He took the punishment we deserved) so they are not recorded. There are other books too and everybody who has ever lived will stand before God on Judgement Day. I don't want to say much about the books as I don't want to get it wrong and mislead you, the point of this thought is really to make us very aware that every single thing we do, say or think, heaven is watching, this should make us very alert to what comes out of our mouths and also concerned, VERY concerned for non-believers. Non-believers will be accountable for every sin and punished with no hope of redemption.

There will be different judgements, one for the saved (2 Corinthians 5:10-11) and another for the unsaved (Revelation 20:11-15). Remember, words are powerful, they cause injury to others, start wars, destroy relationships, oppress people or they can build up, encourage, teach, guide and restore – and it's all being heard in heaven.
