Thought for the Week – from Caroline

Psalm 17:1-5, David's Prayer:

“Hear me, Lord, my plea is just; listen to my cry. Hear my prayer – it does not rise from deceitful lips. Let my vindication come from you; may your eyes see what is right. Though you probe my heart, though you examine me at night and test me, you will find that I have planned no evil; my mouth has not transgressed. Though people tried to bribe me, I have kept myself from the ways of the violent through what your lips have commanded. My steps have held to your paths; my feet have not stumbled.”

Here is Nicky Gumbel's excellent commentary on it from “Bible In One Year” on Friday 27th January. It makes a good *Thought For The Week*:

Determine to stay on God's tracks

David says, ‘My steps have held closely to Your paths [to the tracks of the One Who has gone on before]’ (v.5a, AMP). The Hebrew word for paths literally means ‘wheel-tracks’. David is absolutely determined to stay on God's tracks. In order to stay on God's tracks, you need to watch:

1. YOUR HEART (what you think about): ‘Though you probe my heart, though you examine me at night and test me, you will find that I have planned no evil’ (v.3a).
2. YOUR WORDS (what you say): ‘I have resolved that my mouth will not sin’ (v.3c).
3. YOUR FEET (the places that you go): ‘My feet have not slipped’ (v.5b).
