### Thought for the Week – from Caroline

**For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23)**

Last week in church I shared that one of my non-Christian friends had been put off church because whenever he went or "put his toe in" he was pounced on and the subject of sin was continually brought up.

Of course we do need to talk about sin as the whole gospel is about Jesus coming to show us how to live and about his sacrificial death taking our sin upon himself. But many unchurched people have no concept of sin, not as we know it anyway. A lot of the ways of the world that we know are sinful are an acceptable life style now, so we must chose our words carefully. Some people know absolutely nothing about the Bible, sin, forgiveness and, as for loving your enemies, that can sound ridiculous. The very first thing is to let people know they are loved and valued, and the more complicated teaching can follow gradually. We must be bold but gently and wisely uncompromising with the truth, knowing that we have overcome our many sinful ways and so can new Christians with God's leading and light and His timing.
