Thought For The Week – from Caroline

God wants us to grow up ... like Christ in everything. (Ephesians 4:15a, The Message)

Becoming like Christ is a long, slow process of growth

Spiritual maturity is neither instant nor automatic; it is a gradual, progressive development that will take the rest of your life. Referring to this process, Paul said, "This will continue until we are ... mature, just as Christ is, and we will be completely like Him." You are a work in progress. Your spiritual transformation in developing the character of Jesus will take all your life, and even then it won't be completed here on earth. It will only be finished when you get to heaven or when Jesus returns. At that point, whatever unfinished work on your character is left will be wrapped up. The Bible says that when we are finally able to see Jesus perfectly, we will become perfect like Him. We can't even imagine what we will be like when Christ returns. But we do know when He comes we will see Him as He really is. Much confusion in the Christian life comes from ignoring the simple truth that God is far more interested in building your character than in anything else. We worry when God seems silent on specific issues such as, "What career should I choose?" The truth is, there are many different careers that could be in God's will for your life. What God cares about most is that whatever you do, you do in a Christ like manner. God is far more interested in what you are than in what you do. We are human beings, not human doings.

The Bible warns, "Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out ..." Unlike the surrounding culture, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.
