Thought For The Week – from Caroline

Today is Pentecost Sunday, this marks the fiftieth day after Easter. It celebrates the time when the Holy Spirit descended on the apostles and other disciples and empowered them in their mission to preach Jesus to the world. It is considered to be the birthday of the Christian Church.

The disciples had been gathered together in an upper room when they heard what sounded like rushing wind, then suddenly the Holy Spirit spread through their ranks like a wildfire. They spilled out onto the street and were speaking in a number of different languages, so exuberantly that the many Jews gathered there staying in Jerusalem presumed they were drunk. Peter, the same Peter who was watching the arrest of Jesus from afar and was so afraid he denied he ever knew Jesus, was now so emboldened by the Holy Spirit that he speaks to the crowd, tells them they are not drunk, it's only 9am in the morning. Peter speaks up and says this is what the prophet Joel announced in Joel 2:28-32:

In the Last Days," God says,

"I will pour out my Spirit on every kind of people:

Your sons will prophesy, also your daughters;

Your young men will see visions, your old men dream dreams.

When the time comes, I'll pour out my Spirit

On those who serve me, men and women both, and they'll prophesy.

I'll set wonders in the sky above and signs on the earth below,

Blood and fire and billowing smoke, the sun turning black and the moon blood-red,

Before the Day of the Lord arrives, the Day tremendous and marvellous;

And whoever calls out for help to me, God, will be saved."
