Thought For The Week – from Caroline

1 Samuel 16:7 “...The LORD does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.”

1 Kings 8:39 ends ...for You alone know the hearts of all the sons of men,...

John 2:24 But Jesus would not entrust himself to them, for he knew all people.

Jesus was talking with the Jews, but He didn't trust them. No one needs to tell Jesus about human nature, for He knows each person's heart.

Solomon in the Old Testament says, “God alone knows the hearts of men.” God can know what people are thinking, we can't do that, although we can have a good guess sometimes. What God gives is discernment and words of knowledge, but only if we have given our lives to Jesus and have His spirit living in us. When Jesus died, He made it possible for us to have the Holy Spirit all the time, unlike in the Old Testament when it was only for specific purposes. So we are blessed to have these gifts

Discernment refers to the ability to distinguish between different spirits, such as the Holy Spirit, human spirits, and demonic spirits, or to perceive the true nature of situations and people. Words of knowledge are considered supernatural revelations from the Holy Spirit about specific facts or situations that can be used for guidance or ministry. The gift of discernment is the Holy Spirit's special defence against the lies that come from lying spirits, and we are then able to make righteous judgments.

Jesus knew the Pharisees were a corrupt bunch; Matthew 23:27 says this:

“Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of the bones of the dead and everything unclean...”
