Thought for the Week – from Caroline

Who Jesus is, What Jesus does, and how the Church responds. This was theme for the Church Weekend 2026.

Well we know who Jesus is and we know what Jesus does, but the question is, how does the church respond? We can reflect on the church as a whole but I think the question here applies to us at Broadfield Christian Fellowship, that's BCF.

I think it's long been recognised that we are family oriented, meaning as a community we have a lot of love for each other and we welcome anybody wherever they are on the path of life. However we are not perfect, no church is. Henry & Lydia spoke about the letters to the churches all mentioned in Revelation chapters 2 and 3. These churches had their good points but also where they fell short and what needed to be addressed. I obviously can't go into it all but there were questions like, "Do you actually want to know Jesus, or just what He can do for you? Are we going to let Him in, open the door and surrender? What door is God opening for you now, and what doors need to be shut?"

Some churches in Revelation suffered poverty, persecution, imprisonment and fear of death and another church had become complacent being neither hot nor cold. Both situations call for overcoming. We can overcome as a fellowship or individually but working together in unity. So we need to pray and ask God what He is saying to us as a community of believers and what He is saying to me. One discussion group at the weekend which consisted of Gunilla, Debby, Diane, Stacey and Terry suggested we step out in faith and use the gift of tongues. Also Diane had a picture of a runway with lights all along to guide the plane ready for takeoff, could that be symbolic of the Fellowship? Let's all pray about it.
